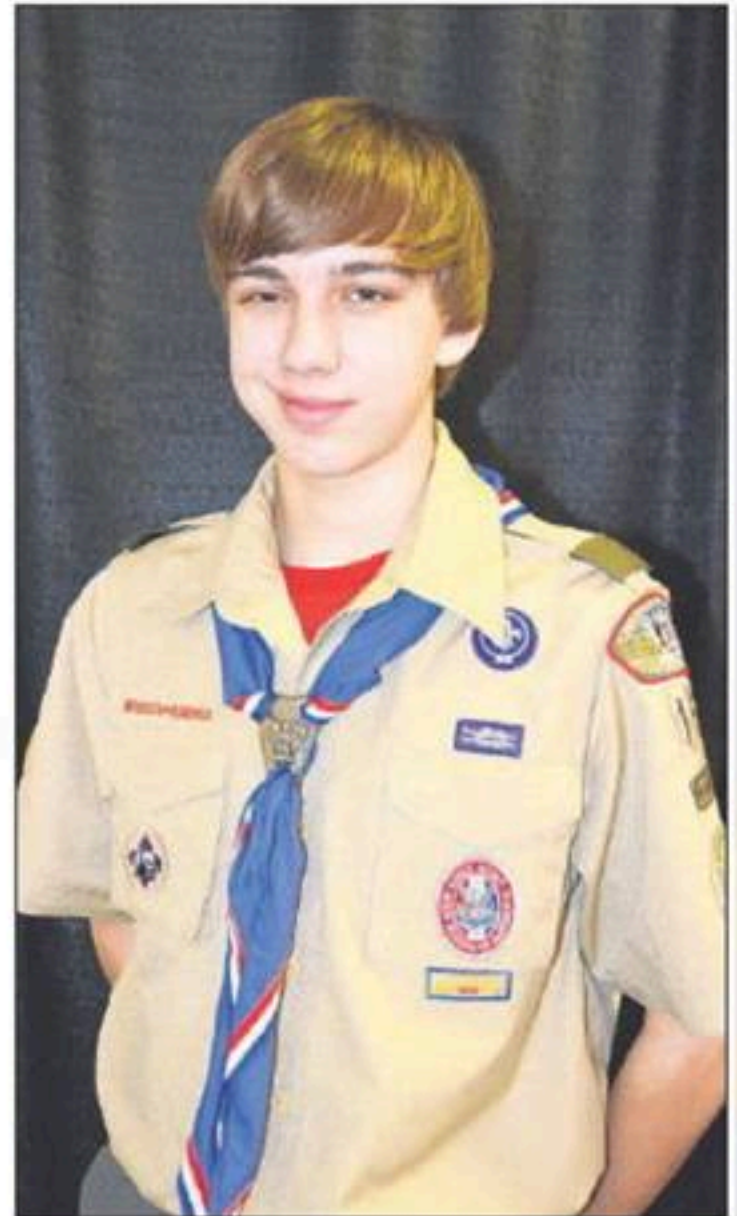


Meet Eagle Scout Zachary 'Wyatt' Horner Watson

Zachary “Wyatt” Horner Watson, the son of Richard and Nancy Watson of Lexington, Ky., is one of 16 Lee County Boy Scouts who earned the rank of Eagle Scout in 2013. Watson, who at the time was a member of Troop 15, chartered by the Auburn Supply Chain Institute, earned 37 merit badges in his efforts to achieve Boy Scouting’s highest rank — including the Rifle Shooting Merit Badge, which he considers his favorite because he enjoys shooting .22 rifles. For his Eagle Scout leadership service project, he and volunteers collectively logged 231 service hours constructing a reading loft for the children’s portion of the Auburn Public Library.
